- Citizen of one of the following countries (Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam)
- Current undergraduate students enrolled in 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> year
- Majoring in computer science and have interests in mobile systems engineering
- Fluent in English
- Mentally and physically healthy and has ability and willingness to adapt to Korean culture and life in Korea

Round trip economy-seat flights, room and board during the duration of the program, travelers insurance, transportation from/to the airport in Korea, fees for the lectures, activities, field trips, and any fees related to lab participation.

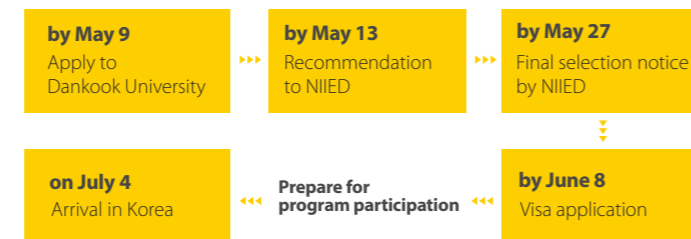

## Lecture Descriptions

### • Introduction to Mobile Technology and Trends

The course provides an introduction to mobile technology and trends. Main topics will include mobile (or wireless communications) technology migration from 2nd generation(2G) to 4th generation(4G), overview of different wireless communication networks such as CDMA (Code Division Multiple Access), WCDMA (Wideband CDMA), HSPA (High Speed Packet Access) and LTE (Long Term Evolution), and the basic concept of wireless communications. The course will also deal with a brief introduction to mobile platforms like Android and iOS, and smart devices. Through this course, students will understand basic concepts of mobile technology (and wireless networks) as well as recent trends.

## Field Trips and Cultural Activities

### • Field Trips

SKT-um, Samsung Innovation Museum, Sangam Digital Pavillion, National Science Museum, Naver, Pangyo Techno Vally, Jukjeon Digital Vally, etc.

### • Cultural Activities

Korean language classes, Ceramics, Korean Movie, Non-verbal Korean Musical, Folk Village, Temple Stay, Mud Festival, Seoul Tour, etc.

## Accommodation

All participants will be placed in an on-campus dormitory room. Each room is furnished with single beds, pillows, desks, chairs, wardrobes, a telephone, wifi, and a private bathroom.
