2. Eligibility

- Citizen of one of the following countries

 Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and Vietnam
- Current undergraduate students enrolled in 2nd to 4th year
- Majoring in computer science and have interests in mobile systems engineering
- Fluent in either English or Korean
- Mentally and physically healthy and has ability and willingness to adapt to Korean culture and life in Korea

6. Lecture Descriptions

• Fundamentals of Mobile Computing

Popularity of mobile computers with wireless networks is a current trend in human-computer interaction technology as well as social lifestyles. The smart-phone was the first mobile computer and tablets came next, replacing the notebook which replaced the desk top computer. Mobile computing is composed of mobile communication, mobile hardware, and mobile software. Communication issues include ad hoc and infrastructure networks as well as communication properties, protocols, data formats and concrete technologies. Hardware includes mobile devices or device components. Mobile software deals with the characteristics and requirements of mobile applications.

Introduction to Mobile Technology and Trends

The course provides an introduction to mobile technology and trends. Main topics will include mobile (or wireless communications) technology migration from 2nd generation(2G) to 4th generation(4G), overview of different wireless communication networks such as CDMA (Code Division Multiple Access), WCDMA (Wideband CDMA), HSPA (High Speed Packet Access) and LTE (Long Term Evolution), and the basic concept of wireless communications. The course will also deal with a brief introduction to mobile platforms like Android and iOS, and smart devices. Through this course, students will understand basic concepts of mobile technology (and wireless networks) as well as secent trends.
